

Tee Mats

Local Rule

- The tee mat defines the *teeing area*.
- You must stand on it and play your ball on it when starting the hole.

Penalty

- Stroke play
 - You get the **general penalty (two penalty strokes)** and must correct the mistake by playing a ball from inside the *teeing area*. If you do not correct the mistake, you are **disqualified**
- Match Play
 - There is no penalty and you play your ball as it lies, **but** your opponent may cancel the stroke in which case you must play from inside the *teeing area*.
- General Play
 - The Tee Mats **MUST** be used in all rounds of golf. Under no circumstances is it acceptable not to comply with these rules where a tee mat is in position.
